As much as possible, historical materials and reports present an unbiased and comprehensive set of primary materials that help both the field historian and later Army historians researching and writing an accurate, objective and full accounting of operations, decisions and actions.

## **FIELD HISTORIANS (IMA):**

(Individual Mobilized Augmentees)  
Army Reserve officers serving at ASCC, Corps and Division level to inform current and future operational planning, document history of the command, interview senior leaders and produce the Annual Command History report.

## **MILITARY HISTORY DETACHMENTS (MHD):**

(Active Duty, Army Reserve & National Guard)  
Officers and NCOs specifically trained and certified to document Army history.

## **UNIT HISTORICAL OFFICER:**

(All 3 Components)  
Army officers or NCOs normally assigned at Brigade level and lower command echelons, in an additional duty capacity, to collect, maintain and report unit specific history.

## **HISTORY SKILL IDENTIFIER:**

(All 3 Components/Officer)  
5X Historian SI available.

(All 3 Components/NCO)  
5X Historian ASI available soon.
