Activated 15 October 1943 at New Orleans, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 31 January 1947 as the 29th Base Post Office

Allotted 15 January 1953 to the Regular Army

Inactivated 25 June 1967 in France

Redesignated 16 September 1988 as the 129th Adjutant General Company and activated at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
