Allotted 10 February 1953 to the Regular Army

Inactivated 28 March 1955 in Japan

Activated 1 August 1962 at Fort Chaffee, Arkansas

Inactivated 15 March 1971 in Vietnam

Redesignated 1 March 1973 as the 147th Adjutant General Detachment and activated in Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1988 as the 147th Adjutant General Company

Inactivated 15 June 1993 in Germany

Activated 17 August 2006 in Germany
