## 235th REPLACEMENT COMPANY

Constituted 15 April 1943 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 72d Replacement Battalion, and activated at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1943 as the 235th Replacement Company

Inactivated 2 July 1946 in Germany

Allotted 1 October 1952 to the Army Reserve

Activated 20 October 1952 at Girard, Kansas

Location changed 31 January 1968 to Centralia, Illinois

Inactivated 22 February 1972 at Centralia, Illinois

Activated 16 October 1990 at Redmond, Washington

Ordered into active military service 27 December 1990 at Redmond, Washington; released from active military service 1 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 12 September 1993 to Bothell, Washington
