Constituted 8 January 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 376th Replacement Company

Activated 15 January 1944 at Camp Croft, South Carolina

Inactivated 28 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 16 May 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 376th Replacement Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 27 May 1947 at St. Louis, Missouri

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 17 November 1950 at St. Louis, Missouri

Redesignated 1 August 1975 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 376th Personnel and Administration Battalion, and activated at Indianapolis, Indiana

Inactivated 1 March 1978 at Indianapolis, Indiana

Redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 376th Adjutant General Battalion and activated at Long Beach, California

376th PERSONNEL COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1997 as the 376th Personnel Services Battalion

376th Personnel Services Battalion ordered into active military service 15 October 2004 at Long Beach, California; released 12 April 2006 from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 2008 as the 376th Personnel Company

Location changed 17 September 2009 to Bell, California
