413th ADJUTANT GENERAL COMPANY

Constituted 6 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 237th Army Postal Unit

Activated 25 March 1944 at Camp Lee, Virginia

Inactivated 15 January 1946 on Saipan

Redesignated 2 December 1947 as the 413th Army Postal Unit and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 10 December 1947 at Kutztown, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 30 July 1959 to Reading, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1972 as the 413th Adjutant General Detachment

Inactivated 30 June 1976 at Reading, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 30 August 1994 as the 413th Adjutant General Company

Activated 16 October 1995 at Bristol, Pennsylvania

Elements ordered into active military service 2 January 2003, 5 October 2004, and 17 January 2005 at Bristol, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 1 January 2004, 2 April 2006, and 15 July 2006 and reverted to reserve status


