Constituted 1 November 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company B, 25th Replacement Battalion

Activated 10 December 1942 at the New Orleans Staging Area, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1944 as the 416th Replacement Company

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippine Islands

Allotted 15 April 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 May 1947 at Newark, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 12 July 1950 at Newark, New Jersey

Redesignated 16 September 1983 as the 416th Replacement Detachment and activated at Gordo, Alabama

Ordered into active military service 22 January 1991 at Gordo, Alabama; released 30 April 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 416th Replacement Company

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Gordo, Alabama; released 8 February 2005 from active military service and reverted to reserve status
