### **444th PERSONNEL COMPANY**

Constituted 27 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 35th Replacement Battalion

Activated 25 January 1943 at New Orleans, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 18 January 1944 as the 444th Replacement Company

Inactivated 1 March 1946 at Calcutta, India

Allotted 20 January 1947 to the Organized Reserves)

Activated 28 January 1947 at Johnstown, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 January 1950 at Johnstown, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 24 November 1967 as the 444th Personnel Service Company

Activated 30 January 1968 at Leetsdale, Pennsylvania

Location changed 15 August 1975 to Oakdale, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1994 as the 444th Personnel Services Battalion

Location changed 31 August 1995 to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania

## **444th PERSONNEL COMPANY**

Ordered into active military service 7 February 2003 at Pittsburgh, released from active military service 12 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 2007 as the 444th Personnel Company
