Inactivated 15 June 1953 in Japan

Redesignated 10 January 1968 as the 556th Personnel Service Company and activated at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Inactivated 1 October 1968 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Activated 16 July 1986 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 556th Personnel Services Battalion
