Constituted 24 May 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 729th Army Postal Unit

Activated 29 June 1944 at Shemya, Alaska

Inactivated 23 August 1948 at Adak, Alaska

Allotted 23 February 1949 to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 21 July 1949 at Cumberland, Maryland

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Cumberland, Maryland; released from active military service 2 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Cumberland, Maryland

Redesignated 16 September 1998 as the 729th Adjutant General Company and activated at Long Beach, California

Location changed 7 December 1999 to San Diego, California

Ordered into active military service 15 March 2003 - 5 November 2004 at San Diego, California; released from active military service 13 March 2004 - 3 May 2006 and reverted to reserve status
