Redesignated 2 March 1949 as the 751st Army Postal Unit and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 28 March 1949 at Ogden, Utah

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Ogden, Utah

Redesignated 10 March 1994 as the 751st Adjutant General Company

Activated 16 September 1995 at New Orleans, Louisiana

Location changed 15 October 2001 to Maui, Hawaii
