795th ADJUTANT GENERAL COMPANY

Constituted 13 January 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 1133d Army Postal Unit

Activated 21 March 1945 in England

Inactivated 8 October 1945 at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 4 January 1949 as the 795th Army Postal Unit and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 1 February 1949 at St. Louis, Missouri

Inactivated 15 November 1950 at St. Louis, Missouri

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 1 October 1959 at St. Louis, Missouri

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at St. Louis, Missouri; released from active military service 13 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 31 December 1965 to East St. Louis, Illinois; on 31 January 1968 to Belleville, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1972 as the 795th Adjutant General Detachment

Location changed 2 February 1973 to Bethany, Missouri; on 1 March 1975 to Kansas City, Missouri; on 1 February 1981 to Richards-Gebaur Air Force Base, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1988 as the 795th Adjutant General Company

795th ADJUTANT GENERAL COMPANY

Ordered into active military service 29 November 1990 at Richards-Gebaur Air Force Base, Missouri; released from active military service 18 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 December 1991 to Bethany, Missouri

Elements ordered into active military service 13 October 1995 at Bethany, Missouri; released from active military service 9 April 1996 and reverted to reserve status

Elements ordered into active military service 2 January 1998 at Bethany, Missouri; released from active military service 28 September 1998 and reverted to reserve status

Elements ordered into active military service 2 December 1999 at Bethany, Missouri; released from active military service 27 August 2000 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 24 January 2003 at Bethany, Missouri; released from active military service 7 April 2004 and 7 May 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 27 June 2005 - 30 August 2005 at Bethany, Missouri; released from active military service 23 December 2006 - 25 February 2007 and reverted to reserve status
