Constituted 6 June 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 661st Replacement Company

Activated 1 July 1945 in the Philippines

Inactivated 31 May 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 21 August 1947 as the 867th Replacement Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 4 September 1947 at New Haven, Connecticut

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 1 May 1951 at New Haven, Connecticut; released from active military service 30 September 1953 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 11 May 1959 to Hamden, Connecticut; on 1 August 1966 to New Haven, Connecticut

Reorganized and redesignated 22 February 1972 as the 867th Replacement Detachment

Inactivated 1 March 1976 at New Haven, Connecticut

Activated 30 September 1978 at Bronx, New York

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 867th Replacement Company

Ordered into active military service 1 April 2008 at Bronx, New York
