Lineage and Honors

877th ADJUTANT GENERAL COMPANY

Constituted 6 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 208th Army Postal Unit

Activated 11 March 1944 at Camp Livingston, Louisiana

Inactivated 1 September 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 25 October 1948 as the 877th Army Postal Unit and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 9 November 1948 at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

Location changed 1 March 1952 to Texarkana, Texas

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1972 as the 877th Adjutant General Detachment

Inactivated 15 September 1988 at Texarkana, Texas

Redesignated 30 August 1994 as the 877th Adjutant General Company

Activated 16 October 1995 at Marion, Illinois; location later changed to Fairfield, Illinois

Location changed 16 September 2000 to Mesa, Arizona

Elements ordered into active military service 16 October 2004 at Mesa, Arizona; released from active military service 13 April 2006 and reverted to reserve status
