Constituted 21 November 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 809th Army Postal Unit

Activated 10 December 1944 in England

Inactivated 31 December 1946 in France

Allotted 8 April 1948 to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 11 May 1948 at East St. Louis, Illinois

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 31 January 1968 to St. Louis, Missouri

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at St. Louis, Missouri

Redesignated 10 March 1994 as the 909th Adjutant General Company

Activated 16 September 1995 at Bothell, Washington

Elements ordered into active military service 12 December 2003 and 11 January 2004 at Bothell, Washington; released from active military service 8 June 2005 and 8 July 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Elements ordered into active military service 5 June 2006 at Bothell, Washington; released from active military service 1 December 2007 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 2008 as the 909th Personnel Company


