Constituted 22 May 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 632d Army Postal Unit

Activated 1 June 1944 in Cuba

Inactivated 15 January 1947 at San Juan, Puerto Rico

Redesignated 22 November 1948 as the 959th Army Postal Unit and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 8 December 1948 at Fort Wayne, Indiana

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1972 as the 959th Adjutant General Detachment

Inactivated 30 September 1976 at Fort Wayne, Indiana

Activated 16 May 1985 at Wenatchee, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 18 September 1991 as the 959th Replacement Company

Location changed 3 January 1994 to Bothell, Washington

Ordered into active military service 26 February 2003 at Bothell, Washington; released from active military service 25 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status
