

DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY Lineage and Honors 113th ARMY BAND (DRAGOONS)

Organized in July 1840 at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, as the Band, 1st Regiment of Dragoons

Redesignated 3 August 1861 as the Band, 1st Cavalry

Redesignated in 1914 as the Band Section, Headquarters Troop, 1st Cavalry

Redesignated in 1921 as the Band Section, Service Troop, 1st Cavalry

Separated 8 July 1927 from the Service Troop and redesignated as the Band, 1st Cavalry

Reorganized and redesignated 15 July 1940 as the Band, 1st Armored Regiment, Light

Disbanded 1 December 1943 in Italy

Reconstituted 21 March 1956 in the Regular Army as the 113th Army Band

Activated 10 April 1956 at Fort Knox, Kentucky
