

Lineage and Honors

107th AVIATION REGIMENT

Organized and Federally recognized 1 April 1979 in the Tennessee Army National Guard as the 670th Air Traffic Control Platoon at Smyrna

Reorganized 1 September 1996 in the Tennessee Army National Guard as the 107th Aviation, a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System, to consist of Company E

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 107th Aviation Regiment

Regiment broken up 1 November 2006 and Company E reorganized and redesignated as the 670th Aviation Detachment

Reorganized 1 September 2007 to form the 107th Aviation Regiment, a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System to consist of the 1st Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 20 June 2011 at Smyrna; released from active Federal service 23 July 2012 and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 September 2014 to Tullahoma
