Constituted 25 April 1966 in the Regular Army as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 222d Aviation Battalion

Activated 25 May 1966 in Vietnam

Inactivated 15 April 1986 at Fort Wainwright, Alaska

Assigned 20 September 1986 to the 101st Airborne Division and activated at Fort Campbell, Kentucky (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Battalion reorganized and redesignated 17 October 1987 as the 222d Aviation, a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System; concurrently relieved from assignment to the 101st Airborne Division and transferred to the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 222d Aviation Regiment
