Constituted 21 June 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 101st Chemical Impregnating Company

Activated 11 July 1942 at Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland

Redesignated 20 September 1943 as the 101st Chemical Processing Company

Inactivated 30 November 1945 in the Philippine Islands

Consolidated 16 August 1983 with the 101st Chemical Detachment (active) (see ANNEX) and consolidated unit reorganized and redesignated as the 101st Chemical Company
