Constituted 11 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 33d Chemical Decontamination Company

Activated 11 August 1942 at Camp Blanding, Florida

Inactivated 17 October 1945 at Camp Swift, Texas

Redesignated 29 December 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 110th Chemical Battalion, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 5 January 1954 on Okinawa

Inactivated 28 December 1954 on Okinawa

Redesignated 9 July 2004 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 110th Chemical Battalion (organic elements concurrently constituted)

Battalion activated 17 September 2005 at Fort Lewis, Washington
