Activated 15 February 1949 at Pine Bluff, Arkansas

Allotted 25 May 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1953 as the 12th Chemical Company

Inactivated 25 July 1966 at Fort McClellan, Alabama

Assigned 1 March 1980 to the 1st Infantry Division and activated at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 15 September 1995 at Fort Riley, Kansas, and relieved from assignment to the 1st Infantry Division

Activated 16 February 1996 in Germany
