Activated 30 March 1942 at Camp Bowie, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 12 December 1943 as the 21st Chemical Decontamination Company

Inactivated 22 April 1946 in Germany

Activated 25 July 1950 at the Army Chemical Center, Edgewood, Maryland

Allotted 25 October 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 21st Chemical Company

Inactivated 20 December 1966 at Fort McClellan, Alabama

Assigned 16 September 1979 to the 82d Airborne Division and activated at Fort Bragg, North Carolina


