Activated 25 March 1942 at Camp Blanding, Florida

Reorganized and redesignated 12 December 1943 as the 25th Chemical Decontamination Company

Inactivated 22 April 1946 in Germany

Allotted 17 February 1949 to the Regular Army

Activated 11 March 1949 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 25 March 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 16 June 1961 as the 25th Chemical Company

Activated 25 June 1961 in Korea

Inactivated 10 November 1970 in Korea

Assigned 21 September 1979 to the 8th Infantry Division and activated in Germany

Relieved 17 January 1992 from assignment to the 8th Infantry Division and assigned to the 1st Armored Division
