Constituted 15 March 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 148th Chemical Warfare General Service Company

Activated 10 April 1945 at Fort Ruger, Hawaii

Inactivated 15 March 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 10 April 1947 as the 310th Chemical General Service Company, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 25 April 1947 at Birmingham, Alabama

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 16 March 1949 at Birmingham, Alabama

Redesignated 22 March 1955 as the 310th Chemical Company

Activated 31 March 1955 at Tampa, Florida

Location changed 18 April 1955 to Fort Myers, Florida; in January 1966 to Clearwater, Florida; on 24 January 1968 to Gadsden, Alabama; on 9 October 1996 to Fort McClellan, Alabama

Ordered into active military service 3 March 1998 at Fort McClellan, Alabama; released from active military service 28 June 1998 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 29 October 2001 at Fort McClellan, Alabama; released from active military service 28 October 2003 and reverted to reserve status
