Constituted 19 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 57th Chemical Maintenance Company

Activated 1 February 1943 at Camp Sibert, Alabama

Inactivated 30 November 1945 at Camp Campbell, Kentucky

Redesignated 17 May 1947 as the 318th Chemical Maintenance Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 27 May 1947 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1953 as the 318th Chemical Company

Inactivated 31 August 1954 at New York, New York

Activated 1 March 1963 at New York, New York

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at New York, New York

Activated 16 April 1984 at Birmingham, Alabama

Ordered into active military service 12 September 1990 at Birmingham, Alabama; released from active military service 20 March 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 27 November 2001 at Birmingham, Alabama;
released from active military service 26 November 2002 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 21 January 2003 at Birmingham, Alabama; released


