329th CHEMICAL COMPANY

Constituted 1 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 122d Chemical Impregnating Company

Activated 1 February 1943 at Camp Sibert, Alabama

Reorganized and redesignated 18 October 1943 as the 122d Chemical Processing Company

Inactivated 30 October 1945 at Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland

Redesignated 11 June 1947 as the 329th Chemical Processing Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 16 July 1947 at Charleston, South Carolina

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 1 August 1950 at Charleston, South Carolina

Redesignated 31 March 1955 as the 329th Chemical Company and activated at Jackson, Mississippi

Location changed 20 July 1955 to Natchez, Mississippi

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Natchez, Mississippi; released from active military service 4 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 July 1964 to Chattahoochee, Florida

Inactivated in December 1965 at Chattahoochee, Florida

Activated 17 September 2005 at Orlando, Florida

Element ordered into active military service 6 August 2006 at Orlando, Florida; released from active military service 1 February 2008 and reverted to reserve status
