## **342d CHEMICAL COMPANY**

Constituted 3 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 115th Chemical Impregnating Company

Activated 29 December 1942 at Camp Sibert, Alabama

Redesignated 18 October 1943 as the 115th Chemical Processing Company

Inactivated 13 October 1945 at Boston, Massachusetts

Redesignated 13 November 1947 as the 342d Chemical Processing Company, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 November 1947 at Boston, Massachusetts

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 2 November 1949 to Fort Rodman, Massachusetts; on 28 December 1949 to Taunton, Massachusetts; on 16 June 1950 to Providence, Rhode Island

Reorganized and redesignated 20 November 1953 as the 342d Chemical Company

Location changed 13 December 1956 to Bristol, Rhode Island

Inactivated 11 May 1959 at Bristol, Rhode Island

Activated 16 September 1987 at Chicago, Illinois
