379th CHEMICAL COMPANY

Constituted 13 January 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 238th Chemical Service Platoon

Activated 12 February 1945 in the Philippines

Inactivated 28 February 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 30 November 1948 as the 379th Chemical Smoke Generator Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 18 January 1949 at Chicago, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1953 as the 379th Chemical Company

Released from active military service 6 January 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Chicago, Illinois; released from active military service 3 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status
