388th CHEMICAL COMPANY

Constituted 13 October 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 168th Chemical Smoke Generator Company and activated at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Inactivated 10 April 1946 at Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland

Redesignated 20 December 1948 as the 388th Chemical Smoke Generator Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 1 February 1949 at Hartford, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 19 August 1950 at Hartford, Illinois

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1954 as the 388th Chemical Company

Released from active military service 27 October 1954 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 17 January 1955 at Hartford, Illinois

Activated 23 April 1956 at Rockford, Illinois

Location changed 31 January 1968 to Bloomington, Illinois; on 16 April 1999 to St. Louis, Missouri

Inactivated 15 April 2005 at St. Louis, Missouri

Activated 16 September 2008 at Junction City, Wisconsin
