Inactivated 6 January 1946 at the New York Port of Embarkation

Allotted 2 July 1952 to the Regular Army

Activated 15 August 1952 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Redesignated 1 December 1953 as the 9th Chemical Company

Inactivated 19 June 1965 in Germany

Assigned 1 September 1981 to the 9th Infantry Division and activated at Fort Lewis, Washington

Relieved 16 February 1991 from assignment to the 9th Infantry Division and assigned to the 199th Infantry Brigade

Inactivated 14 January 1994 at Fort Polk, Louisiana, and relieved from assignment to the 199th Infantry Brigade

Activated 16 October 2012 at Fort Lewis, Washington
