415th CIVIL AFFAIRS BATTALION

Constituted 18 February 1949 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 415th Military Government Company

Activated 4 March 1949 at Saginaw, Michigan

Location changed 5 January 1951 to Fort Custer, Michigan

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 3 August 1956 as the 415th Civil Affairs and Military Government Company

Location changed 1 October 1956 to Kalamazoo, Michigan

Redesignated 1 December 1959 as the 415th Civil Affairs Company

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1992 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 415th Civil Affairs Battalion (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Ordered into active military service 1 December 2003 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 29 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 26 November 2007 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 29 December 2008 and reverted to reserve status

Company A ordered into active military service 16 March 2013 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 19 April 2014 and reverted to reserve status

Elements ordered into active military service 1 May 2015 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 3 June 2016 and reverted to reserve status

Company A ordered into active military service 29 May 2018 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 28 May 2019 and reverted to reserve status

Company B ordered into active military service 25 March 2021 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 24 March 2022 and reverted to reserve status

Company A ordered into active military service 18 January 2024 at Kalamazoo; released from active military service 16 January 2025 and reverted to reserve status
