Constituted 6 December 1955 in the Army Reserve as the 451st Military Government Group

Activated 10 January 1956 at Portland, Oregon

Reorganized and redesignated 13 August 1956 as the 451st Civil Affairs and Military Government Group

Redesignated 10 December 1959 as the 451st Civil Affairs Group

Inactivated 16 September 1979 at Portland, Oregon

Redesignated 16 September 1992 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 451st Civil Affairs Battalion

Activated 16 October 2002 at Pasadena, Texas (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Detachment B ordered into active military service 1 December 2003 at Pasadena, Texas; released from active military service 29 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 24 November 2008 to 1 February 2009 at Pasadena, Texas; released from active military service 24 November 2008 to 1 February 2009 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 20 January 2011 to Houston, Texas

Company C ordered into active military service 11 May 2011 at Houston, Texas; released from active military service 13 June 2012 and reverted to reserve status
