Activated 18 March 1955 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

Redesignated 25 June 1959 as the 41st Civil Affairs Company

Inactivated 28 February 1970 in Vietnam

Redesignated 15 October 2009 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 83d Civil Affairs Battalion (organic elements concurrently constituted)

Activated 18 September 2012 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
