**HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY
158th MANEUVER ENHANCEMENT BRIGADE**

Constituted 3 June 1916 in the Arizona National Guard as the Supply Company, 1st Regiment Infantry

Organized 1 July 1916 in Federal service at Camp Harry J. Jones, Arizona

Drafted into Federal service 5 August 1917

Reorganized and redesignated 3 October 1917 as the Supply Company, 158th Infantry, an element of the 40th Division

Demobilized 3 May 1919 at Camp Kearny, California

Reorganized and Federally recognized 22 June 1923 in the Arizona National Guard at Phoenix as the Service Company (less the Band Section), 158th Infantry, an element of the 45th Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1940 as the Service Company, 158th Infantry

Inducted into Federal service 16 September 1940 at Phoenix

(158th Infantry relieved 23 February 1942 from assignment to the 45th Division)

Inactivated 17 January 1946 in Japan

Reorganized and Federally recognized 14 April 1947 in the Arizona National Guard at Phoenix as the Service Company, 158th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 258th Infantry Brigade

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY 158th MANEUVER ENHANCEMENT BRIGADE

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company,
258th Separate Infantry Brigade

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1964 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company,
258th Infantry Brigade

Converted and redesignated 10 December 1967 as Headquarters and Headquarters
Detachment, 258th Military Police Brigade

Converted and redesignated 1 April 1976 as the 258th Support Center
Location changed 1 September 1996 to Bellemont; on 1 November 2001 to Glendale

Ordered into active Federal service 2 January 2003 at Glendale; released from active Federal
service 5 April 2004 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 20 July 2006 at Glendale

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2007 as the 258th Support Detachment

Released from active Federal service 15 January 2008 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2010 as Headquarters and Headquarters
Company, 158th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade, and location changed to Phoenix
