Ordered into active Federal service 25 January 1991 at Little Rock; released from active Federal service 26 March 1991 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 5 June 2003 at North Little Rock; released from active Federal service 3 June 2004 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 September 2006 with Company D, 212th Signal Battalion (organized and Federally recognized 3 January 1955 at North Little Rock), and consolidated unit reorganized and redesignated as the 1038th Engineer Company

Ordered into active Federal service 5 January 2008 at North Little Rock; released from active Federal service 7 February 2009 and reverted to state control
