Redesignated 30 May 1945 as the 1094th Engineer Utilities Detachment

Inactivated 28 February 1946 in Japan

Activated 30 September 1946 on Saipan

Inactivated 3 May 1947 on Saipan

Redesignated 19 August 1947 as the 10th Engineer Utilities Detachment

Activated 12 September 1947 on Guam

Inactivated 25 January 1950 in Japan

Redesignated 21 July 1965 as the 10th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 August 1965 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam
