Inactivated 25 October 1945 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Redesignated 6 February 1967 as the 113th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 April 1967 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 15 June 1970 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 14 November 2005 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 October 2007 at Milwaukee, Wisconsin
