1249th ENGINEER BATTALION

Constituted 25 March 1959 in the Oregon Army National Guard as the 3d Gun Battalion, 249th Artillery

Organized 1 April 1959 from existing units with Headquarters at Salem

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1961 as the 3d Automatic Weapons Battalion, 249th Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 15 November 1965 as the 3d Battalion, 249th Artillery

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 14 June 1971 as the 1249th Engineer Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 15 March 2003 at home stations; released from active Federal service 7 June 2004 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 1 September 2006 to consist of Headquarters Company and Company A (Company A concurrently organized and Federally recognized at Salem) (remainder of organic elements—hereafter separate lineages)

Ordered into active Federal service 4 December 2010 at Salem; released from active Federal service 7 January 2012 and reverted to state control
