Inactivated 28 February 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 23 February 1954 as the 142d Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 May 1965 at Columbus Army Depot, Ohio

Inactivated 1 December 1965 at Columbus Army Depot, Ohio

Activated 1 November 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 16 October 2007 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii
