Redesignated 8 April 1945 as the 1745th Engineer Searchlight Maintenance Detachment

Inactivated 29 January 1946 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii

Redesignated 31 August 1966 as the 15th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 November 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 16 August 1988 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Inactivated 15 October 1990 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii
