Reorganized and redesignated 15 January 1945 as the 1606th Engineer Map Depot Team

Redesignated 17 August 1945 as the 1606th Engineer Map Depot Detachment

Inactivated 12 November 1945 in France

Redesignated 18 June 1966 as the 160th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 September 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 1 April 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 1 August 1988 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 15 September 1997 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Activated 16 October 2008 at Fort Hood, Texas


