Redesignated 21 January 1955 as the 175th Engineer Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 March 1955 in Germany

Inactivated 25 July 1963 in Germany

Assigned 10 September 1965 to the 196th Infantry Brigade

Activated 15 September 1965 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts

Inactivated 8 December 1967 in Vietnam

Activated 31 May 1972 in Vietnam

Inactivated 29 June 1972 in Vietnam and relieved from assignment to the 196th Infantry Brigade

Activated 2 August 1988 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina


