Ordered into active Federal service 5 January 2005 at home stations; released from active Federal service 1 September 2006 and reverted to state control

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2007 as the Special Troops Battalion, 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team

Ordered into active Federal service 21 April 2009 at home stations; released from active Federal service 25 May 2010 and reverted to state control

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2015 as the 177th Engineer Battalion, an element of the 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team

Ordered into active Federal service 16 November 2018 at home stations; released from active Federal service 30 December 2019 and reverted to state control
