Converted and redesignated 20 July 1966 as the 178th Supply Company

Inactivated 1 September 1968 in Vietnam

Converted and redesignated 15 July 1995 as the 178th Engineer Company

Activated 16 October 2009 at Fort Polk, Louisiana
