Inducted into Federal service 24 February 1941 at Caribou

Redesignated 19 February 1942 as Battery B, 203d Field Artillery, and relieved from assignment to the 43d Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1943 as Battery B, 203d Coast Artillery Battalion

Inactivated 26 October 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Reorganized and Federally recognized 6 January 1947 in the Maine National Guard at Caribou as Headquarters Battery, 152d Field Artillery Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1959 as Headquarters Battery, 1st Automatic Weapons Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 1 June 1961 as Headquarters Battery, 1st Howitzer Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 31 December 1967 as Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 1 February 1972 as Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1999 as Headquarters and Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery

Consolidated 1 October 2001 with Detachment 1, Headquarters and Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery (see ANNEX) and consolidated unit designated as Headquarters and Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as Headquarters and Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery Regiment

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 2008 as the 185th Engineer Company

Inducted into Federal service 24 February 1941 at Fort Fairfield

Redesignated 19 February 1942 as Battery C, 203d Field Artillery, and relieved from assignment to the 43d Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1943 as Battery C, 203d Coast Artillery Battalion

Inactivated 26 October 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Reorganized and Federally recognized 13 May 1947 in the Maine National Guard at Fort Fairfield as Service Battery, 152d Field Artillery Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1959 as Battery D, 1st Automatic Weapons Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 1 June 1961 as Service Battery, 1st Howitzer Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 31 December 1967 as Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Artillery

Redesignated 1 February 1972 as Service Battery, 1st Battalion, 152d Field Artillery
