Constituted 22 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 232d Engineer Combat Company

Activated 1 February 1943 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Inactivated 31 January 1946 in Italy

Activated 1 August 1946 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 6 November 1946 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Allotted 16 January 1948 to the Organized Reserves and activated on Oahu, Hawaii

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 August 1950 on Oahu, Hawaii

Redesignated 27 September 1954 as the 232d Engineer Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 8 October 1954 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts (less detachment concurrently activated in Iceland)

Inactivated 25 March 1962 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Activated 25 March 1967 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 26 August 1968 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Activated 16 September 2006 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri
