Converted and redesignated 22 March 1963 as the 2d Platoon, Company B, 276th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1968 as the 2d and 3d Platoons, Company D, 276th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1971 as Detachment 1, Company D, 276th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1975 as Detachment 1, Company C, 276th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1976 as Company C, 276th Engineer Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 18 December 2003 at West Point; released from active Federal service 14 June 2005 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2006 as the 237th Engineer Company

Ordered into active Federal service 19 July 2007 at West Point; released from active Federal service 21 August 2008 and reverted to state control


