244th ENGINEER BATTALION

Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 244th Engineer Combat Battalion

Activated 25 October 1943 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Inactivated 21 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 26 March 1948 as the 444th Engineer Construction Battalion and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 1 February 1949 at Denver, Colorado

Inactivated 4 December 1950 at Denver, Colorado

Redesignated 25 June 1952 as the 244th Engineer Construction Battalion

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 10 July 1959 as the 244th Engineer Battalion

Activated 1 September 1959 at Denver, Colorado

Location changed January - June 1980 to Aurora, Colorado; on 1 February 1990 to Denver, Colorado

Ordered into active military service 24 February 2003 at Denver, Colorado; released from active military service 17 July 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 30 January 2015 at Denver, Colorado
