Redesignated 15 May 1956 as the 273d Engineer Detachment; concurrently allotted to the Regular Army and activated at Wolters Air Force Base, Texas

Inactivated 24 June 1960 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Activated 1 May 1965 at Granite City Army Depot, Illinois

Inactivated 1 September 1968 in Vietnam

Activated 1 August 1988 at Fort Hood, Texas

Inactivated 20 May 1991 at Fort Hood, Texas


